Point Total	Action Taken	Involvement Level
1-4 points*	Verbal Warning	Assistant Principal
5-9 points	0-1 day suspension	Assistant Principal
10-19 points	2-3 day suspension	Dean of Students
20-29 points	4-5 day suspension	Dean of Students
30-34 points	2 week suspension	Dean of Students/ Principal
35 points	Expulsion	Principal, Executive Board

*Possible dispositions include various forms of school detention.
