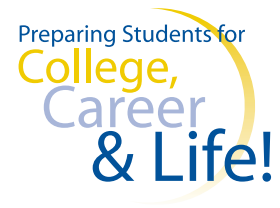

UNIFORM POLICY

In seeking to create an environment and atmosphere that is scholarly and conducive to learning, the Plymouth Educational Center District requires students to adhere to a uniform dress code. The uniform policy is as follows:

Pants/Skirts	Khaki (tan) colored pants must be worn around the waistline at all times. Solid black belt must be worn. All pants must have belt loops through which the belt must be worn.	Khaki (tan) colored skirts must be worn within one inch of the knee. Khaki pants are also acceptable and must be worn around the waistline at all times. Solid black belt must be worn. All pants must have belt loops through which the belt must be worn.
Black Shoes	Closed toe and closed back dress shoes, loafers or lace tops must be worn.	Closed toe and closed back dress shoes, loafers or lace tops must be worn.
Earrings	No earrings	No earrings larger than 1 inch; hoop earrings not larger than 1 inch in diameter

Uniform Policy

Prohibited Apparel

Denim fabrics of any style, tight fitting or baggy oversized clothing items, altered uniform items, stylish belts (electronic, light-up, name plates, etc.), sweat suits, jogging attire, fleece, loungewear or sleep wear, team jerseys, t-shirts, halter-tops, tank/spaghetti straps, strapless or sheer see-through blouses, any headgear (including but not limited to hats, scarves, do-rags, skullcaps or other head covering.

As prescribed in the Plymouth Educational Center Uniform Policy, if a student has selected a manner of appearance that is beyond mere freedom of expression and disrupts the educational process or presents risk to themselves or others, they may be removed from the educational setting.

Students who are representing the Plymouth Educational Center District at an official function or public event may be required to follow specific dress requirements. Usually, this applies to athletic teams, cheerleaders, bands, and other such groups.

VIOLATION OF THE PEC UNIFORM POLICY WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.

Violation of the District Uniform Policy will result in the following sanctions:

- **1st Offense:** Parents will be contacted and notified that their child is not in compliance with the school's uniform policy.
- **2nd Offense:** Parents will be contacted to pick up their child. The child may return to school that day wearing the prescribed uniform.
- **3rd Offense:** Your child will be suspended for one (1) day and will not be allowed to return until a conference with the parent(s) is held.

Chronic violators will not be allowed to participate in any FREE DRESS activities for the remainder of the school year.

I understand and will adhere to the Uniform Policy as stated above. I further understand that if my child(ren) is/are in violation of the PEC Uniform Policy, he/she/they will be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including suspension from PEC.
