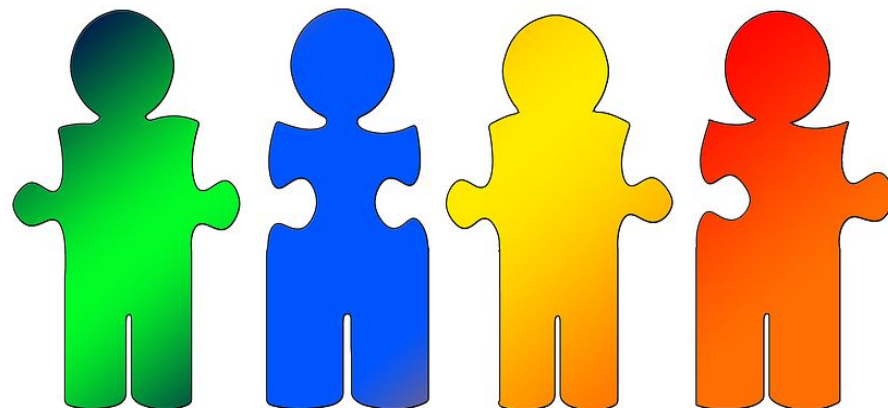

EDUCATION

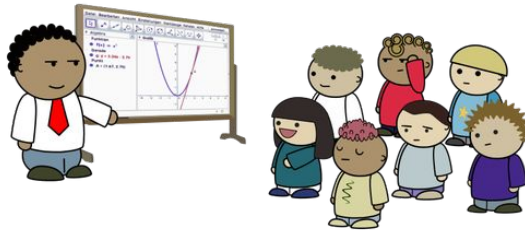
- **When parents and teachers work together as a team,** children do better in school. The parent-teacher conference is an ideal time to get the partnership started.
